
When it comes to getting home safely, it's a good idea to have a back-up plan.

When you're out with friends, you have the right to feel safe. You don't have to get in a car with an unsafe driver. If you're the driver, the safety of you and your passengers is your responsibility. If you feel you shouldn't drive – don't.

Strategies to stay safe:

- Use your Free Pass card (on the next page) and call someone to give you a ride home
- Stay the night at a friend's house
- Catch a taxi or rideshare



How the free pass card works:

- Talk to a parent, caregiver, family member or friend who has a Provisional driver's licence or higher, and ask them to complete and sign your Free Pass Card
- 2. The card is a written agreement between you and that person. If you ever feel like you can't get home safely, they agree to give you a free ride home no questions asked.
- Print and cut out the card on the following page, and keep it with you.
