

TERMS & CONDITIONS



1. Definitions

In these Terms and Conditions:

AANT / we / our means the Automobile Association of Northern Territory Inc.

Inspection means an inspection of your vehicle by an Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre.

Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre means a business that is endorsed by AANT for the purposes of carrying out Inspections of motor vehicles for Members.

Member/you means a current member of AANT.

Terms and Conditions means these terms and conditions.

Vehicle Inspection Report means the written report produced by the Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre after undertaking the Inspection.

2. General

AANT endorses Approved Vehicle Inspection Centres so as to provide Members with a range of quality technical inspections of motor vehicles.

AANT is not undertaking the Inspection.

Your Inspection will be performed pursuant to the terms and conditions you agree with the Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre where you book your Inspection.

AANT's Terms and Conditions:

- will apply when you book an Inspection with an Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre, and
- may be varied by AANT from time to time, and AANT will use reasonable endeavours to notify you of any changes to these Terms and Conditions by placing a notice on our website.

If you rebook the inspection this will mean that the applicable Terms and Conditions will be those applicable at the time you rebook.

A hard copy of AANT's current Terms and Conditions can be made available upon request.

3. Exclusions and limitations

A Vehicle Inspection Report will not tell you everything you need to know about the vehicle including hidden and concealed defects, intermittent problems not apparent at time of Inspection, problems which cannot be identified on a visual inspection or unless parts of the vehicle are dismantled, or which become manifest after Inspection. Older vehicles may contain serious internal, structural or mechanical defects, and whilst every care is taken, such defects may not be detectable from an external visual assessment.

By its nature, an Inspection can only consider the vehicle as at the time of Inspection. You should appreciate that defects may arise after the time of Inspection, which defects were not identifiable or detectable at the time of inspection.

Subject to the requirements of any consumer guarantees which apply under the Australian Consumer Law and cannot be excluded, an Inspection, of its nature, will not necessarily identify all defects with a vehicle. Approved Vehicle Inspection Centres are expected to use generally accepted methods of fault detection in carrying out inspections, but these methods will not necessarily identify all defects.

The Vehicle Inspection Report may only be read and used by you and may not be relied upon by third parties.

Where an Inspection has been requested to assist in making a decision to purchase a vehicle, a Vehicle Inspection Report is not a recommendation to purchase, or not purchase, the vehicle. That decision is for the purchaser to make having regard to such matters as are considered relevant.

Regardless of the contents of the Vehicle Inspection Report, the Inspection does not guarantee that a vehicle will pass a Northern Territory or other state based vehicle registration inspection.

The scope of the Inspection, the work undertaken by the Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre and any other exclusions or limitations that apply will be a matter for you and the Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre and the terms of your agreement with them.

4. Risk to Purchaser

Due to the limitations on the detection and/or analysis of some faults, (those that are internal, concealed or hidden, and/or are not audible within the limitations of our road test) to purchase a vehicle without a warranty from the seller may expose the purchaser to significant risks.

5. Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by law, AANT will not be liable to you or any third parties for any claim (whether that claim arises in contract, tort (including negligence) or statute) for any loss (including loss of profits or special, indirect, incidental or consequential loss), damage, injury or death to any person or property directly or indirectly arising out of or relating to an Inspection performed by an Approved Vehicle Inspection Centre.

The Australian Consumer Law implies warranties or conditions or imposes obligations which cannot be excluded, restricted or modified by service providers except to a limited extent. These Terms and Conditions do not purport to exclude any mandatory statutory rights available to you and must in all cases be read subject to those mandatory statutory provisions. However AANT excludes all your statutory rights and warranties to the extent that it is lawfully able to do so.
